#### OUR WELCOMING RITUAL

### **Our Community Tree of Hands!**

Our hands are a metaphor for life. From the plump, smooth fists we're born with, our hands change as a testimony to the passage of time in our lives. The lines on our palms grow deeper, the skin on the backs thin exposing veins, bones and crevices. Our fingers become bonier with faded prints and misshapen nailbeds. In this way, our hands know the story of our lives. They touched others with tenderness and love; they wiped away tears (both of happiness and sorrow); they cooked, cleaned, dressed, and manipulated all types of technology, electronics and machinery; they expressed applause and delight with clapping; they held our prayers.

As you join this virtual circle, we ask you to bring an object or item that speaks to you at this moment in your life. Consider what draws you to it. Is it how it feels in your hand? How it sounds when it's moved or shaken? How it looks—its colours, shape or the cherished or tragic memory it evokes? Is it a smell that comes to mind? You will raise up this object in your hand as a greeting of community—a reflection of our diversity and uniqueness.

## GUEST SPEAKER: Margaret Keller, CSJ CHARISM ALIVE

Leaving home at age 13 allowed me to witness Sr. Teresita and Sr. Marie Laprise living the essence of the csj charism in the classroom and daily communal living. I entered the congregation at age 16. In our community-run hospitals, I witnessed the healing expression of the charism as a nurse. The dynamic spirit of the charism lead me to chaplaincy in a maximum security detention center and an all-women's university. Retired from institutional ministry I now live in an apartment where a variety of needs beckon me to respond, and individuals without support, have welcomed me into the blessings and challenges of their lives. Throughout these experiences I have lived the dynamic challenges of community living.
